Timeline (full-year or semester)

Hockey is done by semester. In the first semester is Junior hockey academy which includes Grade 8 & 9's. The second semester is for the Senior Grades 10-12.

Travel or equipment requirements

No travel requirements other than getting to the arena. Must have full hockey gear.

Please Note: Transportation to and from the Academy is the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian.



Fees and breakdown

► \$900 for the semester



- Certified Additional Coaches – 25%
- Licences – 3%
- Equipment/Supplies – 13%
- Facility Rentals – 34%
- Apparel – 20%
- Other – 5%

Coaching fees are based on certification, using BC Hockey and Canadian Hockey Association guidelines.

The fee does not cover the salary of the teacher associated with the program.
